From 2000 to presents, I directly supervised one UBC medical student for a two week period of time. This rotation occurs approximately forty weeks per year. Supervision includes Ward Rounds, Trauma, and Elective Clinical Care, and Operating Room Experience.

The focus of my teaching is hand, wrist, and elbow reconstruction as well as general and upper extremity trauma.
